



Monica,

Thank you for your email. I am thrilled to have Treasurer Cisneros on board for the conference. Regarding expense reimbursement, the maximum amount that we can reimburse for roundtrip coach airfare is \$800. For lodging expenses, we will match the cost of one night's lodging at the conference hotel (the Gaylord National Hotel and Convention Center). I know that Treasurer Cisneros will likely stay at another hotel. While that will not be a problem, we will only be able to reimburse him up to \$255 plus taxes (the cost of one night at the Gaylord).
