Second paragraph: "After speaking with her, I was satisfied that she was not in danger."	Lack of foundation. No facts are provided to support this opinion whether Ms. Lopez was actually in danger; and qualifications have not been established to offer an expert opinion on this subject.	
Third paragraph: " I asked whether she had contacted any domestic violence agencies, or attempted to connect Eliana with any domestic violence agencies for support. <i>The woman responded no</i> and became agitated." (Italics added.)	Hearsay. The italicized testimony is not admissible to prove what the person on the phone did or did not do to assist Ms. Lopez.	
Fourth paragraph: "she had not been able to contact him, she was trying to locate him and meet him in person."	Hearsay. The testimony is not admissible to prove whether Ms. Lopez had been able to contact Sheriff Mirkarimi or what Ms. Lopez was trying to do.	

The Mayor requests that Ms. Peralta Haynes appear for cross-examination. Should Ms. Peralta Haynes not appear and testify live, the Mayor objects to the entirety of Ms. Peralta Haynes' declaration.

## 2. **Request for Subpoenas**

The Mayor requests that the Commission issue subpoenas for the following witnesses:

Linnette Peralta Haynes. Good cause exists to issue a subpoena for Ms. Peralta Haynes' testimony because she has submitted a declaration containing information relevant to Sheriff Mirkarimi's conduct on January 4. Cross-examination is necessary to determine the basis for several of the statements contained in Ms. Peralta Haynes' declaration. In addition, the Mayor wishes to present Ms. Peralta Haynes' testimony about information not contained in her declaration, such as the details of Ms. Haynes' communications with Sheriff Mirkarimi and Ms. Lopez on January 4 and before that date, and the extent to which those communications addressed the existence of domestic abuse and how to respond to it. Counsel for the Mayor have contacted Ms. Haynes' counsel to determine her availability to appear on the currently set hearing dates.

**Sheriff Ross Mirkarimi.** Good cause exists to issue a subpoena for Sheriff Ross Mirkarimi's testimony because he has information about his actions related to the charges against him, and the reasons for his actions.

The Mayor may request a subpoena in the future with regard to one or more of the following witnesses, but for the reasons indicated below the Mayor is <u>not</u> requesting the Commission to issue a subpoena at this time:

Eliana Lopez. Ms. Lopez is in Venuezuela. According to news reports, Ms. Lopez and Sheriff Mirkarimi are expected to file a stipulation with the family court to extend Ms. Lopez's stay in Venezuela for another two months, beyond the current court-approved date of June 16. Therefore, Ms. Lopez will continue to be beyond the reach of the Commission's subpoena power.

Ivory Madison and Abraham Mertens. We expect Ms. Madison and Mr. Mertens to submit declarations shortly.

Christine Flores. At the May 29, 2012 hearing, the Commission deferred the issue of how to proceed regarding Christine Flores' testimony in the criminal action. Concurrently with this filing, the Mayor is filing certified official transcripts of the evidentiary hearing in *People v. Mirkarimi*, S.F. Sup. Ct. No. 12001311 (March 2 and March 5, 2012), in which Christine Flores testified and was cross-examined under oath.
