To apply for additional public funds, please write legibly and fill out this form completely; failure to do so may delay your request for funds.

CANDIDATES FOR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

A candidate who is certified as eligible to receive public funds must complete this form whenever he/she seeks additional public funds. The Ethics Commission may disburse public funds to eligible candidates up to \$155,000 to non-incumbent candidates and \$152,500 to incumbent candidates provided that the disbursement will not cause the candidate to exceed his or her Trust Account Limit.

CANDIDATES FOR MAYOR

A candidate who is certified as eligible to receive public funds must complete this form whenever he/she seeks additional public funds. The Ethics Commission may disburse public funds to eligible candidates up to \$975,000 to non-incumbent candidates and \$962,500 to incumbent candidates, provided that the disbursement will not cause the candidate to exceed his or her Trust Account Limit.

¹ Because you cannot make or incur expenses greater than your IEC, the total amount of your paid bills, unpaid bills, and in-kind contributions may not exceed your IEC.

² Candidates for Board of Supervisor and Mayor: Qualified campaign expenditures include in-kind contributions; thus, you must include the amount of in-kind contributions you receive when determining your TAL.

³ A matching contribution is a monetary contribution of up to \$500, other than a loan or a qualifying contribution that is made by an individual, other than the candidate or the candidate's immediate family, who is a resident of San Francisco and that complies with all requirements of the Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance. Matching contributions do not include contributions that are received more than 18 months before the date of the election. S.F. Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code § 1.104(k).
