PG&E, under the auspices of the California Public Utilities Commission, administers a Public Goods Fund designated for energy efficiency programs. Local Governments, Independent Companies, Non-Profit Organizations, etc. receive these funds through a proposal process. The Department of the Environment submitted a proposal and was granted the \$11,540,000 to

implement energy efficiency programs in San Francisco from January 1, 2010 through December 1, 2012. Approximately half of the dollars awarded are spent directly on energy-efficient upgrades to residential and commercial properties in the City.
