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Describe the nature of the contract that was approved:
In 2010, MOH applied to the San Francisco County Transportation Authority for funding under the SFCTA's Lifeline Transportation Program. The SFCTA approved the award of Proposition 1B State Transportation Infrastructure Bond funds deposited into the State's Public Transportation, Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account ("PTMISEA" or the "Funds") from the Lifeline Transportation Program for construction of the public accessible pedestrian connection ("Connection"). Under the terms of the Program, the Funds are provided to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency as an eligible recipient from the State Department of Transportation, serving as the administrating agency for the Funds. In order to facilitate completion of the Connection, SFMTA will provide \$490,160 of the Funds to MOH for distribution to Hunters View Associates, L.P.
