On May 17, 2019, the Ethics Commission notified "Our City Our Home, Yes on C," a ballot measure committee formed in May 2018 for the purpose of supporting increased revenue and support for the homeless in the 2018 elections, that it had been selected as one of 25 campaign audits to be conducted following the 2018 election pursuant to the Commission's audit authority under San Francisco Charter Section C3-699-11(4) and San Francisco Campaign and Governmental Code Section

Administrative Closure of 2018 Election Cycle Discretionary Audit of Our City Our Home, Yes

on C, sponsored by Salesforce.com, Inc. and the Coalition on Homelessness

For the 2018 audit cycle 16 audits conducted were of committees controlled by candidates seeking elective City office who received public campaign financing in their campaigns. Another 11 noncandidate committees were identified for discretionary audits by objective criteria. The Commission received committee records in June 2019 and began its preliminary audit work at that time.

Because of competing demands that have been placed on the Ethics Commission's limited Audit program resources since that time, including as a result of staff vacancies and emergency service worker deployments throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, I have at this time exercised my discretion as Executive Director to administratively close the audit of the Our City Our Home, Yes on C committee. The Commission will not be issuing a written audit report and notice of my determination to administratively close this discretionary audit with no findings will be placed on our 2018 Audit Report web page for purposes of public transparency. In addition, I have asked the Commission's new Audit and Compliance Review Manager Linda Fong contact you to coordinate with you on the return of the Committee's audit records as may be needed.
