Anonymous public comment received on February 10, 2023:

I am calling to support the nomination and election of Chair Yvonne Lee to a second and final term as Chairwoman of the San Francisco Ethics Commission.

Chair Lee has tremendous leadership and policy experience, having served as Presidential appointees to the US Civil Rights Commission and U.S. Small Business Administration, the national director of the Chinese American Citizens Alliance and on the San Francisco Police Commission. She has brought and continues to brings her leadership an invaluable insight and perspective to the policy and oversight work of the Commission, including the passage of the Anti-Corruption and Accountability Ordinance, the overhaul of enforcement regulations and the Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance.
