Independent Expenditure Verification	<b>Ongoing</b>	Within 10 days	<a href="#">462</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Committees making independent expenditures must file this form with the FPPC via email.</li> <li>Committees file only one Form 462 per election for each candidate or measure supported or opposed by an independent expenditure.</li> </ul>
Mid-Year Semi-Annual	<b>July 31, 2024</b>	* – 6/30/24	<b>461</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All committees must file this statement.</li> </ul>
Year-End Semi-Annual	<b>January 31, 2025</b>	7/1/24 – 12/31/24		

**\*Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1 if no previous statement has been filed.

## Additional Notes:

- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday.
  - This extension does not apply to a Form 497 that is due the weekend before the election
  - This extension never applies to any Form 496.
- **Form 511 – Paid Spokesperson Report:**
  - File within 10 days of making either of the following expenditures related to an advertisement to support or oppose a ballot measure:
    - 1) a payment totaling \$5,000 or more to an individual to appear in an advertisement, or
    - 2) a payment of any amount to an individual portraying a member of a licensed occupation (e.g., nurse, doctor, firefighter).
- **Method of Delivery:** All Committees identified in CGCC 1.112(b) must electronically e-file campaign statements using the method identified on the webpage titled [Complete List of Campaign & Public Financing Forms](#).
- **Late Filing Fines:** Late filed statements required to be e-filed will be assessed a \$25 per day late fine, until the statement is e-filed. Late filed statements required to be filed on paper will be assessed a \$10 per day late fine, until the statement is filed.
- **Public Documents:** All forms are public documents.
- **Advertisement Disclaimers:** Many advertisements require disclaimers. [Please review disclaimer charts](#) for specific disclaimer requirements.
- **Committee Status:**
  - A city committee may make contributions or independent expenditures in connection with other elections.
  - Generally, a city committee is one that spends more than 70% of its funds in connection with elections in one city.
  - See [FPPC Regulation 18227.5](#) to determine whether your committee is a city, county or state committee.
