(S.F. Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code § 1.128)

**Instructions:** By filing this statement, a candidate for Assessor, Public Defender, City Attorney, District Attorney, Treasurer, Sheriff, the Board of Education or the Community College Board agrees to accept the applicable voluntary expenditure limit, which is as follows:

Candidates who wish to accept the voluntary expenditure ceiling must file this statement no later than the deadline for filing nomination papers. The Ethics Commission will post on its website a list of candidates who have accepted the voluntary expenditure ceiling. A candidate may not accept the applicable expenditure ceiling if the applicable expenditure ceiling has already been lifted by the Ethics Commission.

Any candidate who indicates acceptance of the voluntary expenditure ceiling and who then makes campaign expenditures that exceed the expenditure ceiling, at a time when the expenditure ceiling has not been lifted, is subject to penalties.

The Ethics Commission will not accept for filing any Form SFEC-128 that modifies any of the printed language below. **If you do not want to accept the voluntary expenditure ceiling, do not file this form.**
